Honey-B-Healthy, Inc. recommends preparing syrup using the following steps. Allow syrup to cool to room temperature prior to adding Honey B Healthy® feeding stimulants.

Syrup Preparation Steps



SPRING & SUMMER

- Mix syrup at a ratio of
SUGAR:WATER
1:1

FALL



- Mix syrup at a ratio of
SUGAR:WATER
2:1

- Bring syrup to a boil, if desired, or just use warm water to dissolve sugar. (Boiling is unnecessary with Honey B Healthy® products.)

- Allow syrup to cool.

- Add HONEY B HEALTHY® and AMINO-B BOOSTER® stimulants per recommended dosage chart below.

Mixing Ratios

(US Standard)

Recommended starting dose - 1 tsp. per quart.

FEEDING STIMULANT or DRENCH

Amino-B Booster®	Honey B Healthy®	Syrup
1-2 tsp.	1 tsp.	1 Quart
4-8 tsp.	4 tsp.	1 Gallon

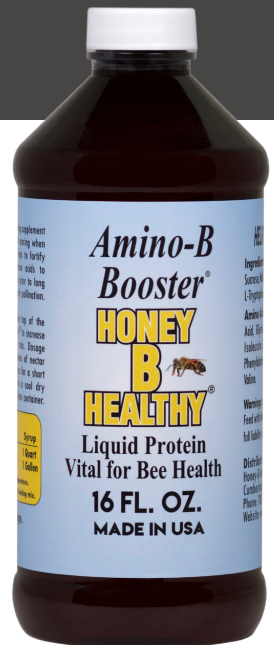

Feeding Stimulant

Adding equal amounts of Honey B Healthy® Original and Amino-B Booster® to syrup will provide important overall health benefits to the colony while helping to keep the syrup fresh.

FEED WITH HONEY SUPERS OFF.

Drench

Drench using the same mixture as used for feeding. Drench weak colonies with 8-12 ounces to give them a boost for brood rearing.

IMPORTANT:

Use clean feeding containers. If storing mix for a short period of time, keep tightly sealed, dry and cool. Do not return mix back into container. Avoid using prior to long winter clusters unless preparing colonies for early pollination.
